#### **NIGERIA MARKS ONE YEAR OF NO NEW POLIO CASES**

This month, we reflect on the incredible work being done at a global and local level to move us closer to a polio-free world. Here is what has happened recently:

- Nigeria marked one year since the most recently reported case of wild poliovirus
- The same milestone across the entire African continent with a year since the most recently reported case in Somalia.
- More than half of the world's new-borns now receiving at least one dose through their routine immunization systems

### THE WORLD POLIO POSITION

As a global community we still need to raise another \$1.5 Billion to complete the job and it can be done. Look at WPV2 cases. It has now been officially eradicated.

**WPV1 cases:** 48 cases have been reported this year vs. 221 cases at the same time in 2014. (22% of 2014 position.)

- 36 cases in Pakistan vs. 186 cases at the same time last year. (19% of 2014 position.)
- 12 cases in Afghanistan \* vs. 10 cases at the same time last year.
- Nigeria now is polio-free.
- No cases in any of the 6 non-endemic countries that reported cases in 2014 vs.19 cases then. (5% of the total number of global cases last year.)

WPV2 cases: Now officially eradicated. (Last case in October 1999 from Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh.)
