

Castleton RYLA is a four day course supporting the leadership development of 16 and 17 year olds- Year 12 and Year 13.

The Rotary Clubs are invited to send up to two young people on this course (<u>one male</u> and <u>one female</u>).

Candidates must be at least 16 and **not yet** 18 years of age at the time of the course. Your club are asked to select suitable young people from schools or youth organisations who show leadership potential. As Rotarians we recognise that today's young people will become tomorrow's leaders and this course will support them in their personal development by helping them to find out more about themselves, creating a testing environment to explore skills and behaviours, creating challenges both physical and mental, teaching how to be effective and confident leaders and encouraging involvement in the wider world.

During the course they will be a member of a team of like minded young people and will undertake a series of activities that will place them in charge of the group on a rotational basis. The candidates will benefit by learning new skills, experiencing how to make effective decisions, recognising skills in others, understand the problems of leadership, learning from their own mistakes and building confidence through presentation skills, working and co-operating together. The activities will mainly be based in the outdoors, however, this course is <u>not an adventure holiday</u>. We will be using the outdoors as a tool to highlight the personal development and learning points.

The cost of the course is £150.00 and funding can either be from a sponsor or from your own club funds.

We will accept reservation deposits of £25.00 per person (Cheques to be made payable to RI District 1220). Places will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. The maximum number of places are 32 (16 male and 16 female).

Once we have confirmed that your club has secured one or two places, you will need to identify your candidates **by 31**st **December 2016** by getting them to complete the 'Application Form' (attached) from each young person and sending the balance of £125.00 p.p.

After this date, additional places may be available to clubs.

The sponsoring Rotary Club is responsible for organising the transportation of their candidates to and from the course. They are to arrive by 10.30am on Thursday 23rd February and are to be collected at 3.00pm on Sunday 26th February.
