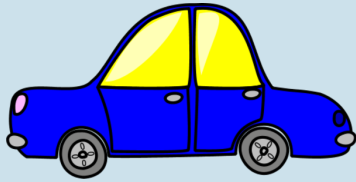


Please remember

What is Castleton RYLA?

The Rotary Leadership Award is a four day course supporting the leadership development of 15 and 17 year olds.

During the course, participants will be part of a team which will undertake a series of activities. Participants will be in charge of the group on a rotational basis.

The activities will mainly be based in the outdoors however, the course is not an adventure holiday. We will be using the outdoors as a tool to highlight the personal development and learning points.

It succeeds by :-

- Helping the participants to find out more about themselves
- Creating a testing environment to explore skills and behaviours
- Creating challenges, both physical and mental
- Teaching how to be effective and confident leaders
- Encouraging involvement in the wider world
